

**PARTICIPATION RULES**  
***Ticket to Health Contest***  
**by Accès pharma chez Walmart**

1. The Contest is organized by Walmart Canada Corp., operating under the business name Accès pharma chez Walmart (hereinafter referred to as the “Contest Organizer”). It will run from 12:01 a.m. (ET) on Monday, October 28, 2024, until 11:59 p.m. (ET) on Friday, December 13, 2024 (hereinafter referred to as the “Contest Period”) on the Accès pharma chez Walmart website: [ticket2healthcontest.ca](https://ticket2healthcontest.ca).

**ELIGIBILITY**

2. This Contest is open exclusively to residents of Quebec aged eighteen (18) or older, with the exception of (i) employees of the Contest Organizer and all Accès pharma franchisees, Walmart employees or subsidiaries, affiliated groups, affiliated companies, franchisees, advertising agencies, successors, or agents of the aforementioned groups; and (ii) individuals residing with any of the aforementioned persons.

**HOW TO ENTER**

3. To enter, simply visit [ticket2healthcontest.ca](https://ticket2healthcontest.ca) and complete the entry form to be eligible for the grand prize and twenty (20) secondary prizes.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. To be eligible for the Contest, you must complete all required fields in the online entry form.

**Limit of one entry per person and per email address for the entire Contest Period.**

**ODDS OF WINNING**

4. The odds of winning the grand prize depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period.

The odds of winning one of the secondary prizes depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period.

**DRAW**

**5. The draw for the grand prize and the twenty (20) secondary prizes will take place at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 17, 2024, and will be conducted electronically.**

Twenty-one (21) entries will be randomly selected from all participants who entered during the Contest Period. The first randomly drawn entry that complies with these rules will be awarded the grand prize. The following twenty (20) randomly drawn entries will each receive one of the secondary prizes.

## **PRIZES**

6. The grand prize is: five thousand Canadian dollars (CAD 5,000) in the form of a travel gift cheque.

6.2 The secondary prizes include five (5) Walmart gift cards valued at \$500 each, and fifteen (15) Walmart gift cards valued at \$100 each.

**The total value of all prizes that can be won in this Contest is nine thousand Canadian dollars (CAD 9,000).**

All expenses related to the acceptance of any of the prizes are the sole responsibility of the winner, fully releasing the Contest Organizer from any liability.

## **PERSONAL INFORMATION**

7.1 By participating in this Contest, all participants consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of their personal information by the Contest Organizer and its authorized agents for the purpose of administering this Contest and awarding the prizes. 7.2 Participants agree that their name, address (city, province), voice, statements, image, photos, or other representations and recordings may be used through any media, including but not limited to the internet, for promotional or advertising purposes without any further notice or compensation, and they may be required to sign a document to this effect. Participants' personal information will not otherwise be used or disclosed without their respective consent.

## **GENERAL RULES**

8. To be declared a winner and claim the prize, the selected participant must meet the following conditions:

- A. Be reachable by email or telephone at the email address or phone number provided on the entry form, within five (5) business days following the draw or the first communication from the Contest Organizer;
- B. Meet the Contest's eligibility conditions, particularly having completed and submitted the entry form during the Contest Period;
- C. Sign the declaration and release form, which will be sent by mail or email, and return it to the Contest Organizer within ten (10) days of its dispatch date.
- D. If the randomly selected participant does not meet any of the conditions above or any condition set out in these rules, they will be disqualified without notice, and a new draw will take place until a winner is determined for that prize.

9. Upon receiving the duly signed declaration and release form, the winner will be notified by phone or email on how to claim their prize.

10. None of the sponsors, affiliates, or franchisees of the Contest Organizer (hereinafter the "Group") shall be held responsible for the use of the prizes awarded in this Contest, nor shall they assume any liability with respect to the prize or any events arising from the Contest. The winner will be required to sign a declaration and release form to this effect.

11. The entry forms submitted by participants may be subject to verification by the Contest Organizer, if necessary, notably to confirm that they comply with these rules. Any illegible entry forms, those submitted after the Contest Period, or obtained from unauthorized sources will not constitute an eligible entry for winning any of the prizes. Any person who participates or attempts to participate in this Contest using means contrary to the spirit of the Contest and in a way that is unfair to other participants (e.g., hacking, multiple entries, fraudulent entry submissions, etc.) will be automatically disqualified and may be reported to the appropriate legal authorities. The decision of the Contest Organizer in this regard is final and cannot be appealed.

The Contest Organizer assumes no responsibility for entry forms received after the Contest Period, lost, stolen, misdirected, illegible, incomplete, falsified, altered, or destroyed entries, which will be deemed null. The Contest Organizer assumes no responsibility for any issues, malfunctions or technical problems affecting a network line, online computer system, phone peripheral, software, server, provider, email, browser, platform, or site, nor for any technical malfunction that may occur, including but not limited to problems with the transmission or non-transmission of an entry form, regardless of the cause. The Contest Organizer is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by users of the website or by equipment and/or programs associated with or used by the Contest, or by a technical or human error that could occur during the Contest, including during the processing of entry forms. The Contest Organizer assumes no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, loss, defect, transmission failure, communication line failure, theft or destruction, unauthorized access to entry forms, or any modification thereof. The Contest Organizer is not responsible for any injuries or damages resulting from the conduct of the Contest. The Contest Organizer reserves the right to destroy all documents related to the Contest once the legally required retention period has expired.

The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend the electronic component of the Contest if a virus, bug, or any other factor beyond the control of the Contest Organizer compromises the security or proper management of the Contest. Any attempt to deliberately damage any website or undermine the legitimate operation of this Contest is a violation of criminal and civil codes, and, in such a case, the Contest Organizer reserves the right to seek remedies and claim damages in accordance with the law, including filing criminal charges. Entries are subject to verification and will be declared void if they are mechanically reproduced, damaged, counterfeit, falsified, altered, or tampered with in any way.

14. The winner acknowledges that the fulfillment of services related to the prize is the sole and exclusive responsibility of the service providers. The winner must sign a clause to this effect, included in the declaration and liability release form.

15. The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to substitute a prize of the same nature or of equivalent value in the event that the prize or any part of the prize becomes unavailable, for any reason whatsoever. Subject to the above, the prize must be accepted as awarded and cannot be exchanged for cash.

16. The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, or suspend the Contest in the event that a virus, computer bug, unauthorized human intervention, or any other cause beyond the Organizer's control corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, or proper operation of the Contest, subject to approval by the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux of Quebec.

17. Once the prize has been awarded to the winner, the Contest Organizer assumes no responsibility for situations in which the prize might be affected, such as the closure of

the establishment, a change of owner(s) or manager(s), labour disputes, or any other circumstances that could directly or indirectly affect the winner's prize.

18. This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and municipal laws and regulations. The decisions of the Contest Organizer are final in all matters related to the Contest.

The winner agrees to sign a clause to this effect, included in the declaration and liability release form.

No correspondence will be conducted with participants regarding the Contest except with those whose entry form has been randomly drawn.

22. Any dispute regarding the organization or conduct of this promotion may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for resolution. Any dispute regarding the awarding of the prizes may be submitted to the Régie solely for the purpose of resolving the issue in a fair manner.

23. This Contest is not managed or sponsored by Facebook. The information provided by participants is given to the Contest Organizer, not to Facebook. By participating in this Contest, each participant acknowledges that Facebook cannot be held responsible for any aspect of the Contest and releases Facebook from any liability in this regard.
